iourney back in time at Woodbridge

The blinds came up on the store-front windows of the old Channel Emporium in Woodbridge on the weekend of August 13 and 14, drawing eyes and imaginations into the past.

Visitors were warmly welcomed into the village for the Back to Woodridge Weekend, part of the Woodbridge Life 2022 program of events celebrating life in and around Woodbridge

The weekend began outside the entrance of the Woodbridge Community Hall, with a Welcome to Country, by Woodbridge resident Graeme Seabourne.

The Kingborough Chronicle joined in the historic tour of the village, commencing in the Hall, with a rich and fascinating collection of old maps, photos, artefacts, historical information and anecdotes on display.

There was much to be discovered

Stories within stories, some of which will be shared with readers over coming weeks.

Appropriately, the exhibition commenced with a display of traditionally woven baskets and a kelp water vessel, reminders of the connection to country and culture of the district's original inhabitants, the Palawa people.

The European township of Peppermint Bay

(Woodbridge) originated from 1828, when the site was selected as the local peppermint gum was in high demand for shingle timber for rooves of buildings in Sullivans Cove (Hobart).

The region is significant in the history of Tasmania, and the displays spoke volumes on the strength and passion of the villagers and surrounding inhabitants, past and

The windows of the old Channel Emporium offer a glimpse into a bygone era, revealed through a fascinating collection of wares.

It was a journey back to yesteryear.

The ground floor of the historic two-story building, dating back to the 1800's was a drapery, ironmongery, grocers, a bakery and butcher's shop.

The wares have been gathered and curated by Catherine Mason, with assistance from her mother Lee Mason.

Catherine is the great granddaughter of Albert Mason, whom, together with his brother Reg Mason, bought the store from Fred Lucas in 1910.

Lee Mason and her husband Rod, grandson of Albert Mason, ran the nearby general store, then known as Mason's Store, for around 20 years.

The general store has been transformed by today's operators Pieter and Ally Snyder, into the Woodbridge Village Store Café and Emporium, complete with a cosy wood fire and a generous selection of homemade meals, desserts, and fresh scones.

The passion for Woodbridge is undying.

Chair of the Woodbridge Life 2022 Committee, Graham Rae said anyone who missed the Back to Woodbridge weekend exhibition can catch it on display in the Channel Museum during September.

The next event on the Woodbridge Life calendar is the Small Wonders of Woodbridge exhibition of artworks, curiosities and memorabilia that relate to life in Woodbridge

Huon Highway section reopens

The Huon Highway section adjacent to the Kingston Wetlands reopened slightly early on Thursday afternoon, August 11.

The road had been closed between the Channel Highway and the Huon Highway roundabout to enable a pedestrian underpass to be installed.

Works are scheduled to continue at the site for another six to eight weeks, with temporary traffic management conditions in place, whilst remaining work is completed.

Kingborough Council said the principal contractor, DCS Civil, has completed a significant amount of work during the road closure period, reducing the expected timeframe for construction.

Road users are requested to continue to follow the signage and drive carefully through the area, for the safety of the construction crew.

Council has thanked the community for their patience during this time.

Anti-viral medication

Tasmanians aged over 70 who test positive for COVID-19 are able to access anti-viral medication on the Pharmaceutical Benefits Scheme (PBS), to reduce the severity of illness and the risk of hospitalisation.

Anti-viral medication is also available for people aged over 50 with two or more risk factors for severe disease, and Aboriginal or Torres Strait Islander people aged over 30 with two or more risk factors for severe disease.

"If you are at higher-risk and get sick with COVID-19

as possible", stated the Tasmanian Department of Health in a media release on August 9.

"Antivirals must be prescribed by a doctor.

"If you don't have a regular GP or they are not available, doctors at GP-led Respiratory Clinics can provide guidance on how to access antivirals if you are eligible.'

Anyone who tests positive for COVID, must register their test at www.coronavirus.tas.gov.au, or by calling the Public Health Hotline on 1800 671 738.

To access anti-viral treatment, contact your GP or usual health care provider in the first instance, or call the COVID@homeplus team.

Community lending for essentials

A Tasmanian-based No Interest Loan Scheme (NILS) lifted its loan limit in July to help those on low incomes with cost-of-living pressures.

"As cost-of-living bites," said NILS Tasmania CEO John Hooper, "we are raising the limit on our no interest, no fees, no charges loans to \$2000, from \$1500"

"Those applicants experiencing family violence situations will be eligible for a loan of up to \$3000," Mr Hooper said.

"This new lending limit will allow more Tasmanians on a low income to be able to buy that essential fridge, washing machine or dental treatment that their family

"We know the mental and emotional stress of debt and not feeling in control of your finances is crippling and destroys families.

"Last year NILS Tasmania provided over 3416 Tasmanians with loans.

"Our loans help our clients and the local economy." According to the NILS Tasmania website, to qualify for an Essential Loan, an applicant will need:

- A current healthcare card, pension card, DVA card, or low-income healthcare card. Or have a gross income of \$55,000 or less
- To live in stable accommodation (exceptions can be made in some cases).
- Capacity to repay the loan.

Mr Hooper said the increase had been "enabled by Good Shepherd Australia New Zealand (our national community sector partner), the Federal Government through the Department of Social Services who fund the no interest loan program across Australia (including NILS Tasmania) and our capital partner National Australia Bank".

"NILS Tasmania in May provided 15 per cent of the no

interest loans issued nationally even though Tasmania is just 3.4 per cent of the national NILS eligible population," continued Mr Hooper.


"That reach and impact is possible because of the State Government's backing of NILS Tasmania.

"Our heroes are the 400 volunteer loans officers, spread through 75 community organisations, neighbourhood centres and electorate offices that help people complete our simple loan application though 100 different community access points across Tasmania."

Local organisations or delivery points that can assist with applications include Kingston Neighbourhood House, Salvation Army (Hobart), Hobart City Mission and Anglicare Hobart.

Book binder's cricket keeper

The Lions Club of Kingborough held its biggest book sale ever, in Taroona in July.

Tables were filled with near-new gems and long-lost treasures, waiting to be discovered.

Here's a true tale, told to us by Lions Club of Kingborough's Ken Hughes, about a treasure found.

Lost treasure found buried in a Taroona book sale

The book Test Tussles On and Off the Field, authored by D.K. Darling, and published in 1970, is a sporting memorabilia collectors' item.

"The author J.K. Darling was the son of a great Australian cricketer and test captain Joe Darling, explained Ken Hughes.

"In the foreword, Sir Donald Bradman gave the opinion that Joe Darling's 1902 side was one of the best teams to ever tour England."

Back in the day, young Barry Nicholson, of Kingston, owned a signed copy of Darling's book.

Working as an apprentice book binder at J. Walsh and Sons, Barry had helped bind copies of the book. He completed his apprenticeship in 1970, the year Darling's book was published.


Sometime in the 1980s, Barry lent his prized possession to someone, and, as often happens, it was not returned. So began Barry's search for a replacement copy, with many outings to markets and second-hand book sales. Unbeknown to Barry, the search would go on for another 40 years.

Then one day, in 2022, Barry's brother-in-law Greg Collis ventured into the depths of the annual Lions Club of Kingborough Book Sale in Taroona.

And there it was, unearthed.

"Barry could hardly believe his eyes when Greg turned up at his house with a copy of the book," wrote Ken Hughes. "Finally, the search was over."

"The Taroona Book Sale was first held in 1968 and has grown from strength-to-strength over the 54 years it has been running," noted Ken Hughes, as a postscript. "Lions Club of Sandy Bay started the Lions chapter in 2013, and Lions Club of Kingborough was handed the reins in 2015.



Once upon a time in 1970, Barry Nicholson (pictured) of Kingston owned an original, printed and bound, signed copy of D.K. Darling's book Test Tussles on and off the Field. Alas, the book binder and his treasured book parted ways the following decade. The wicked spell was broken when the two were finally re-united in July 2022. (PS)


