# Kingborough raises the flag for transgender pride

With a historic flag raising last week, Kingborough Council officially launched its LGBTIQA+ Action Plan.

Kingborough Mayor Paula Wriedt said the launch of both the LGBTIQA+ Action Plan and the raising of a flag to commemorate Transgender Day of Visibility demonstrated Council's commitment to creating a community that is inclusive, safe, welcoming and respectful for all.

"The LGBTIQA+ Action Plan was created by a diverse community group who engaged with our community to gather ideas about what Council could do to improve inclusiveness," Cr Wriedt said.

"This Action Plan provides a voice for our LGBTIQA+ community, and highlights some immediate, low-cost actions that will go a long way to supporting inclusion.

"I look forward to implementing this Action Plan with my colleagues and thank members of our community for bravely raising their voices to this important initiative.

"One of the actions in the Action Plan is to fly flags at our Civic

Centre to commemorate significant events and raise awareness about LGBTIQA+ experiences and achievements.

"The Transgender Pride Flag is the first flag to be flown on the council's community flagpole.

"Transgender Day of Visibility is about raising awareness, increasing visibility and recognising the achievements and lived experiences of trans and gender diverse people.

# Consultations now open

Kingborough Mayor Paula Wriedt has announced the start of six weeks of community consultation on the 2023/24 Council Budget.

"Every year, Kingborough Council plans how we can best service the needs of our community, through developing our budget," Cr Wriedt said.

"Demands grow every year for new and existing services and we need to create and maintain our built infrastructure and look after our many natural assets that benefit the community.

"We understand that households are under increasing pressures due to the rising cost of living.

"Council is also experiencing increased costs.

"This Draft Budget aims to meet the community's expectations by ensuring staff have the resources to deliver a range of services and projects that benefit our

"This year, Council is proposing a 4.5 per cent residential general rate increase along with a 7 per cent commercial and industrial rate increase.

"Kingborough remains a low rating Council among Greater Hobart Councils and this draft budget is centred around maintaining this.

"Budget feedback can be provided to Council until 14 May 2023 through a survey, written or emailed submissions.

"All feedback will be given to Councillors as they consider the draft budget.

"Council will formally decide on the draft budget at the 13 June 2023 Council Meeting."





## More vaccines available through your local pharmacy

The Tasmanian Government is cutting red tape by expanding the list of eligible vaccines that can be administered by a local pharmacist.

Tasmania's pharmacist immunisers will now be able to administer selected vaccines not currently covered under the National Immunisation Program (NIP).

This includes a range of vaccines, including vaccines for shingles, and travel vaccines, when they have been prescribed by a medical or nurse practitioner

In many cases, this will remove the need for Tasmanians to return to their medical practitioner to have the vaccine administered after it has been dispensed by a pharmacist, reducing the time spent by the patient and also reducing pressure on medical practitioners.

Premier and Minister for Health Jeremy Rockliff said this expansion goes a long way to expanding the health space and making it easier for Tasmanians to access health care.

"Under the previous guidelines, Tasmanians would need to visit their medical practitioners to receive a script, visit the pharmacist to collect the vaccine, and return to the medical clinic to have it administered," the Premier said.

"We're cutting this down to not only reduce pressure on our medical clinics but also save time for the patient.

"We know every minute counts for our health workers. "We continue to progress new and innovative ways to make health more accessible and affordable for all Tasmanians and this is yet another example of that.

"Just a few weeks ago we saw the introduction of continued dispensing, allowing Tasmanians to access a one-off supply of their long-term medications - this is already seeing impressive results.

"We know how valuable the role of our skilled pharmacists is within our health system, and we will continue to work with them as we identify what other services they can safely provide to the community."

This expansion of vaccines includes non-NIP vaccines approved for use by the Therapeutic Goods Administration, except those where specialised training, screening or regulatory conditions apply.

Some vaccines will continue to only be able to be administered by medical practitioners.

The expansion does not include vaccines for tuberculosis, vellow fever, Q fever and mpox.


The broader scope of practice review is scheduled to be completed by June and will provide independent and evidence-informed advice to government on options to expand the pharmacists' scope of practice.

#### **Realise the dream for cystic fibrosis**

May is 65 Roses month, when the profile of cystic fibrosis (CF) is spotlighted in the community.

Cystic fibrosis (CF) is a genetic condition primarily affecting the lungs and digestive system but affecting many other parts in the body.

Kingborough resident Jen Hauser, a physiotherapist who has worked in CF for over 20 years, is taking up the 65 for CF Challenge, a campaign launched by Cystic Fibrosis Tasmania (CFT).

CFT is a not-for-profit organisation receiving no government funding and provides essential support and services to those impacted by CF living across Tasmania.

These services include provision of life-saving equipment used in the daily burdensome treatments to maintain lung health, and financial support towards physical and mental well-being programs.

'65 for CF - Realise the Dream' is a local campaign encouraging individuals to do a challenge in May around the numbers 6 and 5 and raise awareness and funds for cystic fibrosis.

65 roses came about in the US when a young boy couldn't pronounce the name of his condition and called it '65 roses' instead.

All funds raised go directly to CFT.

The challenge is only limited by your imagination, as long as it includes a 6 and a 5 in it.

Jen and her family will be taking up the challenge in a number of ways.

One challenge, which they have done for over a decade, is to rally 65 or more people to join their team '65 Roses for CF' in the City to Casino Family fun run event.

Jen asks that you wear red, a tutu, a cape, a mask, a wig, and let people know you are participating to paint the town red and raise awareness for cystic fibrosis.

Jen and her youngest daughter will also be once again donning their red tutus for the entire month of May and smashing out 65 kilometres walking around Kingston and Blackmans Bay.

Jen will also complete 65 exercise sessions on a fitness app in May.

She currently does some of these exercise sessions virtually with individuals with CF across the state as part of her role as a physiotherapist and is looking forward to challenging herself to do more.

# New cameras to reduce Tasmanian road toll

The State Government is taking further action to reduce deaths and serious injuries on our roads.

New automated traffic enforcement cameras with the ability to detect illegal mobile phone use and seatbelt offences are hitting Tasmanian roads this month for testing. Minister for Infrastructure and Transport Michael Ferguson said dangerous drivers who break the law, risking their life and others, are on notice.

"These cameras are important because distraction and seatbelt non-compliance are a factor in 24 and nine per cent respectively of Tasmania's fatal and serious injury crashes," he said.

"The delivery of a new fleet of automated traffic enforcement cameras around the State is a major action in our ongoing efforts to save lives and reduce road trauma.

"The announcement coincides with the presentation to the Legislative Council today of the Tasmanian Government's response to its Select Committee Inquiry into Road Safety."

The inquiry made 49 recommendations to improve

road safety, with 37 of these recommendations in place, underway, or already under consideration.

As of March 12, over 18,000 confirmed speeding offences have been detected since the speed cameras were introduced in September 2022.

"Following the testing period, enforcement is expected to commence mid-year," Minister Ferguson said.

"The new automated camera program is supported by the 'Over is Over' campaign, which challenges motorists to rethink their attitudes to speed and encourages them to adjust their behaviour by not driving over the speed limit.

"This follows the introduction of a package of enhancements to the driver graduated licensing system to prepare Tasmanians for a lifetime of safe driving.

"The enhancements included increasing the number of supervised driving hours during the learner licensing phase. "Every death and serious injury is an avoidable tragedy.

"The Government does not accept any level of road trauma and is committed to its long-term vision of zero serious injuries and deaths."





## **Storytelling at Margate Primary**

At Margate Primary School, they have observed that a class of children listen to a story more intently when you are telling them in person.

No book as a prop, just a group of people who sit together. They not only remember the story, but are able to connect with it, share it later, and meld it seamlessly into their own stories.

The power of this is such that they have devoted a specialist program to storytelling, or 'Story Circles.'

Sitting on First Nations designed mats in one of the many beautiful bush spaces at the school they work in groups to learn and demonstrate storytelling techniques.

They are often interrupted by curious yellow-tailed black cockatoos or one of their much-loved school chickens trying to lay an egg.

Other extensions of this learning are literacy programs, including '*Stories under Kunanyi*' and '*Words* Make Me Fly' which are designed to challenge and extend small groups of students to write or tell their stories.

"Stories Under Kunanyi" students learn from their

teacher, a published author, to use First Nations culture as a backdrop for telling stories.

These include using symbols and making stories in the sand and shell-stringing using beads as a way to retell important life moments

'Words Make Me Fly' is aimed at extending groups of avid creative writers to give them skills and build enjoyment of writing which the school hopes will be life-long

It is taught through a platform of learning about the desert in Central Australia, exposing Tasmanian kids to a very different landscape and inspiring them through the bellows of male emus, the feel of eagle claws or running their hands through the rich red sands of the desert.

These diverse programs aim to give all students a chance to shine and share their voices with the world.

Students who voice their opinions on the storytelling comment that, "I like how we get to share stories and speak, and no-one judges you" and, "I like being able to share some really special stories that are going to stay






