Ferry long wait

The Department of State Growth recently announced that upgrades to the Roberts Point and Kettering Bruny Island ferry terminals would be completed in December.

Labor Member for Franklin Dean Winter raised concerns over delays to these upgrades.

Mr Winter said new jetties were constructed well over two years ago, but other berthing infrastructure is yet to be installed.

When SeaLink won the contract to run the Bruny ferries in 2018, the Tasmanian Government said an online booking service would be gradually introduced but limited stand-by capacity would remain

The Tasmanian Government said consideration of a pre-booking system was paused until the berthing duplication is completed and Mr Winter said locals and visitors deserve to know what the government

"The new jetties have been ready for a long time but they can't be used," Mr Winter said.

"If the ramps aren't ready people will again have to queue to get

"I share the frustration of locals on the island and at Kettering with the congestion and the delays.

"Why is this taking so long?"

Minister for Infrastructure and Transport Michael Ferguson said new ramps and gantries are now being fabricated off-site.

"The contractor was delayed by the technical challenges encountered ensuring the new vessels and the ramp interact correctly," Minister

"They advise that additionally, the pandemic caused a change in lead times for some critical winch components, lasting up to 54 weeks, not including shipping.

"The final installation is about to begin, and we expect it to be completed before Christmas, weather permitting.

"We've got greater capacity than ever and much improved queuing arrangements.

The upgrades include:

- Improvements to queueing areas at Roberts Point and Kettering
- Duplication of ferry loading ramps to reduce single ramp dependency and allow for faster loading and unloading of vehicles
- Improved traffic management for more orderly and safer boarding.

Salmon donations for Kingborough charities

Huon Aquaculture, with help from local charity groups, launched a new community support initiative on Thursday, September 21.

This program will regularly donate salmon to provide essential protein products to families facing financial challenges in the Kingborough area. Charities accepting Huon's contributions include the Kingston Neighbourhood House, Kingborough Helping Hands, the Salvation Army Doorways Program in Blackmans Bay and the Kingborough Family Church in Huntingfield.

Each of these organisations will receive between 20-30 kilograms of Huon's premium salmon products.

Edna Pennicott from Kingborough Helping Hands spoke about the

increasing number of people seeking food assistance in recent

"Our demand has more than doubled in the last three to four

"We now take out approximately 70 meals a night when we go out. "We also make meal deliveries to elderly people who are living on their own and people who are sick and struggling.

Edna thanked Huon Aquaculture for their support.

"The salmon donations are just wonderful," Edna said.

"We will be able to use them to make meals, which will be a real treat for some people.

"We couldn't do what we do without the donations that we receive."

Last week's trial run saw Huon donate more than 220 kilograms of salmon products to 10 local charity organisations in both the Kingborough and Huon regions.

The new program represents a meaningful step toward addressing food insecurity and supporting those most affected by the cost-

"We understand that the cost-of-living crisis is making it difficult for many families to afford protein products right now," Huon Aquaculture's

Community Engagement Coordinator Sammy Kluga said. "We hope that our salmon donations will assist some of those families who are facing tough times in Kingborough at the moment."

Debates over compostable dog poo bags

Compostable dog poo bags are being deliberated over at Kingborough Council for the 2024/25 financial year.

Kingborough Mayor Paula Wriedt said Council deliberated over introducing compostable dog poo bags considering the financial and environmental costs of doing so, at the September 18 Council meeting.

"In Kingborough there are 115 dog bag dispensers in various locations which all use 760,000 degradable dog poo bags a year," Cr Wriedt said.

"These dog poo bags are currently sent to landfill.

"There have been many requests for Council to start using compostable dog poo bags in our dispensers.

"Unfortunately for compostable dog poo bags to work properly they must be commercially composted

"To do this would require a completely new service estimated to be approximately \$250,000 per annum."

At the meeting, Council discussed the environmental benefits that would come from swapping the current

degradable dog poo bags for composting ones. In particular, the benefit of reducing the amount of plastic used in our community.

"Whilst it would be fantastic to reduce the amount of plastic, the fact is the bags still end up in landfill and don't compost, which is not ideal," Cr Wriedt said.

"As a Council we will revisit this discussion during the 2024/25 Budget process, weighing up the \$28,000 cost and how it would be collected through dog registrations."



Locals needed for Long-COVID studies

Michelle Brookfield from Blackmans Bay has been experiencing COVID symptoms for 18 months.

Her symptoms include severe fatigue, headaches, light and sound sensitivity, insomnia, heart palpitations, and

Michelle is on medication now which helps with her brain fog, although she still suffers memory issues.

"There's preliminary studies showing these things help but the doctors won't prescribe them because they're not completed studies," said Michelle.

"They still shake their head at you, and no one knows what to do and can't help.'

Cardiologist Professor Tom Marwick at the Menzies Institute for Medical Research is one of the leaders of

the PERCIEVE study which is seeking to improve understanding of Long-COVID and the appropriate treatment response to this problem.

"Participants undergo a series of screening questionnaires about health, wellbeing and physical activity, walking tests of exercise capacity, and some of them undergo an echocardiogram and formal exercise stress test," said Prof Marwick

"Suitable participants will be randomly allocated to medical therapy (if there is cardiac involvement, which is rare) and exercise training by a personal trainer.

"Progress is tracked over 12 months."

Michelle has been selected as a PERCEIVE participant. Michelle is a registered nurse but she does not know if she will ever be able to return to work.

'You feel like a zombie, like you've been sedated," Michelle said.

"The kids are missing out on me."

The Long-COVID PERCEIVE study currently has 36 Tasmanian participants randomised into the study with several more undergoing screening.

Professor Marwick said they are actively looking for more people who are aged over 40 years, had a COVID infection and are experiencing ongoing symptoms.

Local government Code of Conduct changes

The local government sector has welcomed the recent changes to the Code of Conduct framework that passed Parliament recently.

Consultation on the changes first occurred in mid-2021. Local Government Association Tasmania (LGAT) President and Break O'Day Mayor Mick Tucker said "Improving the Code of Conduct is a high priority for the sector, as the current framework is failing us"

"The current system spends unnecessary time and resources on dealing with trivial matters, while on the occasions when serious misconduct occurs, the framework fails to sanction the breaches adequately.

"These shortcomings are at the core of the local government sector's concerns over the framework".

The key changes endorsed by Parliament include requiring councils to implement a local dispute resolution policy, with the aim of resolving most issues via a mediation process before a complaint is heard by

To support the local mediation process, there is a new requirement for the Code of Conduct Panel to dismiss a complaint if the person making it does not adequately

try and resolve the issue through the dispute resolution process.

The sector is cautiously supportive of the changes, Cr Tucker said.

The test of how successful they will be if the Code of Conduct panels are prepared to dismiss complaints that are trivial, vexatious or that do not participate in dispute resolution meaningfully.

"We look forward to working with the State Government on the further changes needed to ensure a safe workplace for elected representatives," Cr Tucker said.
